The Research Proposal is a complete description of the intended research, developed under the supervision of the assigned supervisor. This document is meant to assist you in setting out the proposal, in terms of text layout, section headings and sub-sections. The full research proposal must be between 5 and 10 pages and should present the following:

 - ✓ Diagrammatic conceptual frame
 - List of independent (explanatory) and dependent variables; and expected independent variable regression coefficients (parameters). These can be obtained either from the theoretical postulates or published literature.
